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Paper structure:

Title (in Hungarian and in English – only in the case of Hungarian authors)

Name and personal details of author(s), name of institution

Összefoglalás in Hungarian (only in the case of Hungarian authors)

Abstract in English

Keywords (max. 5)

JEL classification (https://www.aeaweb.org/jel/guide/jel.php) – obligatory at least 1 Library of Congress Classification (LCC kód, https://www.loc.gov/catdir/cpso/lcco/) – obligatory at least 1

Introduction

Material and Methods

Results

Conclusions

References (based on the specifications of the scientific field, but 10 references might be required, in case of referring to papers with DOI, please indicate it in the reference list)

Font type and size: Times New Roman 12p

Spacing: simple
Lengths: 10-15 pages
Margins: 2,5 cm round
Page numbering: none





Detailed format requirements

TITLE IN HUNGARIAN (IN CASE OF HUNGARIAN AUTHORS, PAPERS)

TITLE IN ENGLISH

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Összefoglalás (in Hungarian – in case of Hungarian author)

max. 500 characters, justified.

Abstract (in English)

max. 500 characters, justified.

Keywords: Keyword1, Keyword2, Keyword3, Keyword4, Keyword5

JEL classification: GE11

LCC: S560

The chapter titles must be in size 12, bold, the sub-chapter titles must be in size 12, italics. Please, try to avoid too many sub-chapters. Please do not give numbers to the chapters, sub-chapters. Please put tables in order as tables, and photos, diagrams and flowcharts etc. as figures, starting with "1". Tables and figures must never get out of the margins.

Format requirements for tables:

The ordinal number and the title of the table must be above the table in bold, centered, and the source must be below, in italics on the left.

For example:

Table 1: Population of settlements, 1st of January, 2012.

Settlement name	Number of population
Budapest	1 740 041
Gödöllő	34 172

Source: Hungarian Central Statistics Office, 2012.

Format requirements for figures:

The ordinal number and the title of the figure must be directly below the figure in bold, centered, and the source in the next line, in italics.

Please avoid the followings in the paper:

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References

In the script authors and dates must be referred. If the author or the literature is not referred directly, the name and the date must be put in brackets, separating the name and the date by a comma. If the paper refers to more than one literature from an author which were published in the same year "a, b, c (...)" letters must be sign the different literatures. E.g.: (Csete, 1987/a); (Csete, 1987/b.)

Both authors and the date must be signed if the referred literature has more than one author, e.g.: (Bernáth – Enyedi, 1981). In the case of three or more authors the first author's name must be written down, signing that there were more authors too, e.g..: (Szerdahelyi et al., 1980). In the references bibliography, however, every authors' names must be written down. To give the name of editor first comes the name then in brackets that he/she was the editor, e.g.: Székely (szerk. vagy ed.).
